



We've got your back, and your front, and your side..... **DOOR THAT IS!**

You never know who may be knocking at the door. It could be a parent, a delivery person, or a bad guy. If you are involved in the operation of a church administration office, day care center, fire department station, school, small retail business, or an industrial facility; you need to know about *DoorCall™*!

You are looking at a revolution in access control security technology. It is called a *DoorCall System*. This is a product conceived, designed, manufactured, and serviced in the United States of America to make every door in the USA safe from day time intruders. Here's how it works.....

In recent times small business offices and stores, day care centers, and others have been forced to take the safety precaution of locking all doors during the day. Providing a means of announcing, identifying, and providing access to visitors has become a difficult process.

Camera systems require the user to be at a fixed location, as do wired intercom systems. Day care workers, shop owners, and office/plant workers are seldom at a fixed location. The proprietor of a small day care center recently came to us for a solution. We didn't have one. We knew that a wireless call box and one or more 2-way radios would work, but they were too expensive, both in terms of hardware and installation. Something better was needed. Now, we've got it!



The day care operator provides a password to all parents. Any parent coming to pick up a child at an unscheduled time must give the proper password to the nursery worker who is equipped with a wireless personal communicator as shown on the left. If the visitor doesn't have the correct password, they don't get in, and most importantly, they don't get the child! Other visitors can be verified for entry before access is granted.

That little white box at the top of the page is a call button controller that is connected to an internal wireless transceiver (the black box) that can communicate directly with one or more 2-way radios worn by staff workers. You can place one of these inexpensive devices (just \$745 without radio or \$995 with a portable radio as shown above) at any locked door where you wish to provide controlled access by parents, outside staff, or vendors.
