

# Burch's Navman Demo Instructions

It's easy to set up Navman. Here's how you can begin tracking my vehicle within just few minutes. Let's get started!

First, go to <http://onlineavl2.us.navmanwireless.com/OnlineAVLSetup>. The Navman system uses Microsoft .NET Framework Version 2 or later. If you already have Microsoft.Net installed on your Windows or VISTA PC, just click on "Install" or follow the instructions. After installing, your file will be saved in your programs (*All Programs* for Windows XP). Open your programs. You will see a new program entry for *Navman Wireless*. Click on the file and you will see an icon entitled *Online AVL2*. Right click on the icon to save to your desktop. This will allow you to easily return to the program later.

Now that you have the icon on your desktop, click on the icon to open the program. Insert the Login of *navmanshow* and the Password of *navmanshow*. A list of names will appear on the left and a map of the last vehicle reported location on the right.

My name (Burch) is at the top of the users in my fleet. Click on my name and the map will change to show my present location within the last ten minutes. If parked, you will see when I stopped and whether my ignition is ON or OFF (A blue key symbol at the left with an "X" indicates my ignition is OFF). If I am parked with the ignition ON, the key color would be green – you'll never see that on my vehicle! By the way, if you want to see all the vehicles in my fleet, you can zoom in or out using the slide bar on the right. The map is very easy to use – it's Microsoft Virtual Earth.

If I happen to be moving when you check the map, you can move your cursor over my vehicle symbol on the map to display my location and speed. If I am moving, my location is updated every ten minutes. If you want to know my exact current location without waiting for an automatic update, just click on QUERY on the second line at the top left section of the page (under VEHICLE).

All of my current driving activity for the day is shown under Vehicle Activity at the center left section of the page. As you will note, every stop over ten minutes is recorded as well as speed and location. If you want a report of my previous day's activities, click on VEHICLE on the top line of the page. When the sub-menu appears, click on REPLAY DAY. The prior day will appear. You can change this to any date of your choosing. By default, the system will choose the prior day. When the selected date appears, you will see a report on the left and a map showing activity on the right – pretty neat huh?

For tracking vehicles, this is all you need to do. You get all of this for the basic \$42.99 monthly package. Add \$8 per month and you get the ability to send messages to my vehicle (and I can send messages to you as well). I have this feature in my vehicle. If you would like to send me a message, go back to the top of the page, then click on SEND MESSAGE on the second line at the left. When the message entry screen appears, just type in your desired message and hit OK at the bottom of the page. As soon as I receive your message, I can acknowledge receipt.

Leave your Navman system active for my reply. By the way, you can leave Navman ON all the time. It takes very little bandwidth. Just minimize to your system tray and you'll be ready for a message at all times.
